What Was Nailed To The Cross?

There are five systems of LAW in the Bible.

- A. The Laws of Nature. Genesis 1:14,16
1. The law of gravity.
 2. The law of seasons.
 3. The law of the tides of the ocean.
 4. The law of the rising and setting of the sun.
 5. The laws of nature are still in operation. They have not been nailed to the cross.
- B. The Laws of Health.
1. Your body is the temple of God. You are bought with a price. I Cor. 6:19,20
 2. Don't defile your body temple. I Corinthians 3:16,17
 3. Do all to the glory of God. I Corinthians 10:31
 4. The laws of health are still in operation. They were not nailed to the cross.
 - a. If you ignore the laws of health, they'll nail you to the cross.
- C. Civil Law
1. Tailored for the Jewish nation, Numbers 35:11,12
 - a. We don't have cities of refuge today. This civil law of the Bible was just for the Jewish nation, when they functioned as a nation under God.
 2. In principle, civil law is to be obeyed.
- D. Ceremonial Law.
1. Leviticus 7:37 Governed the sacrificial system.
 - a. Read Leviticus 23 and Hebrews 7, 8, 9.
 2. Pointed forward to Christ, a shadow of things to come, and was nailed to the cross. I Corinthians 2:14
 - a. We can study and learn from the ceremonial laws today because their ultimate fulfillment is in Jesus. But to actually observe the ceremonial laws in to deny their fulfillment in Christ.
- E. Moral Law. The Ten Commandments
1. This is the basis of God's government. It will never change. Psalm 89:34
 2. Six of the commandments are written into civil law in

3. Some people say, "You don't have to keep the ten commandments to be saved."
 - a. Why, you have to keep them to be free. How much more important it is to keep them for God!
 4. God writes His law in your heart. Hebrews 8:10
 - a. Christ did not destroy the moral law. Matthew 5:17
 - b. It is perfect and holy. Romans 7:12
 - c. Grace does not make God's law void. Romans 3:31
