What Really Happens When You Die? (Review)

Satan is intensifying his work to deceive the whole world before Jesus comes. He has had 6 millenniums to get his great deceptions together for the end of time.

Rev. 12:12 He has a clever counterfeit for everyone of God's truths. Matt. 24:24; 1 Timothy 4:1 And one of those truths that he has been using to deceive people on from the beginning of this world is the subject of "death". In fact his first lie was "You will not surely die" Genesis 3:1-5. And His first lie will be his last lie. We are no match for Satan unless we are standing firmly on the solid rock of God's word.

- Man does not have a soul he is a "soul". Dust + Breath = Soul (living being). Soul is mentioned 100's of times and never once is it called an IMMORTAL SOUL. Gen. 2:7
- "The soul that sins it shall die" Eze. 18:4 "Man is subject to death, God ALONE has IMMORTALITY. Job 4:17
- Man does not receive immortality until the second coming- at the RESURRECTION. 1 Cor. 15:20-23,51-55
- Man waits till the change comes at the resurrection. (MORTAL becoming IMMORTAL.) Job 14:14
- Death is mentioned as sleep in the Bible 66 times. Jesus equated death with sleep. John 11:11-14
- Again death is equated with sleep, and the people of God (righteous) that have died, are sleeping (unconscious) waiting for the resurrection at the second coming of Jesus. 1 Thess. 4:13-17
- "spirit" is RUACH in the O.T. and PNEUMA in the N.T. and is used interchangeably with BREATH, AIR, WIND, SPIRIT. Dust minus Breath (spirit) = death or no soul. Eccles.12:7
- The dead are coming back but not to their house. They are coming back all right but not now! They're coming back at the

coming of Jesus; at the resurrection. Meanwhile there are no messages from the grave or dead loved ones.

BECAUSE THEY ARE DEAD waiting for the resurrection.
Job 14:12; Job 7:9,10; Ps. 146:3,4; Eccles. 9:5,6,10

- The Bible gives a strong warning against dabbling in the OCCULT world. Lev. 19:31; Lev. 20:6,7,27; 1 Chron. 10:13,14; Isa. 47: 13,14; Isa. 8:19,20
